

Ante-Nuptial Announcement.

NEW YORK, May 3.—The marriage of Miss Gloria de Cespedes to Mr. Charles Abnon de Lima will take place at the Waldorf on Monday, May 11. The bride elect is the daughter of Mme. de Cespedes, widow of Carlos Manuel de Cespedes, first President of the Cuban Republic, who was killed in the revolution of a quarter of a century ago. The ceremony is to be a quiet one. Carlos Manuel de Cespedes, twin brother of the bride, landed an expedition in Cuba a few months ago, and is now Governor of one of the Cuban provinces. During the earlier futile contest for independence in Cuba, Mme. de Cespedes was sent to this city. The birth of her twin children followed soon after her arrival. The boy and girl were never seen by their father. His will ordered that his son should stand in the same relation to Cuba in any future struggle. Mr. de Lima is a South American, and is connected with the banking house of I. A. de Lima & Co.
